EVENT CONDITIONS OF PLAY – FINAL

- 1. These **Special Conditions of Play** need to be read with Bowls Auckland's General Conditions of Play.
- 2. Scheduled dates:
 - a) Qualifying 27-28 December 2024
 - **b) Post Section** 29 December 2024
- 3. Venues:
 - a) The headquarters and post section are at Howick Bowling Club.
 - b) Other venues will be advised with the release of the draw.
- 4. Times:
 - a) Round one will commence by 9:00 am on each event day.
 - **b)** All subsequent rounds should be starting promptly to ensure the day runs efficiently
 - i. All players are to fill out start and finish times on scorecards

5. General Format:

- a) Pairs Each player will play four (4) bowls per end under the 2-4-2 format.
- b) All Games will be played over 14 ends, with no time limit.
- c) If an end becomes dead, it must be replayed, in the same player sequence.
- d) If a game ends in a draw, an extra end will be played, a coin will be tossed to determine the choice of the mat. Play will resume in the same playing order as the first end.

6. Qualifying Play:

- a) Entries will be drawn into sixteen sections of eight or part thereof. (entries capped @ 128)
- b) Pairs will be positioned randomly into a predetermined rink allocation draw
- c) Teams will play five (5) qualifying rounds over two (2) days, three (3) games day one, two (2) games day two

7. Byes / Defaults in qualifying:

- a) Should there not be an even number of teams then sections may contain a bye.
- b) Should a team default a game, the non-offending team shall be treated as having a bye.
- c) The team with a bye will receive a win, the average scores for and against, from all teams in the same section of that round.

8. Determining Qualifiers:

a) In all qualifying games, one (1) game point will be awarded for each game won, and the section rankings will be the team with:
 The highest game points, then
 The highest net total of shots, then

The lowest shots against.

9. Post Section – Division Playoff:

- a) Post-section will be split into four divisions,
 First place in section goes to division one.
 Second place in second goes to division two.
 Third place in section goes to division three.
 Fourth place in section goes to division four.
 All other finishers are eliminated from the competition.
- b) The first post-section round will be played as a sectional playoff against the section they share the green with on day two.

10. Post Section - Finals Day:

- a) All finals will be at Howick Bowling Club, commencing at 9:00 am.
- **b)** The eight teams (from each division) will be blind drawn to determine who plays who in each respective competition.
- c) Games will be a straight knockout.

11. Restricting the movement of players during play:

- a) In all games, players will only be allowed to walk up to the head under the following circumstances.
- b) The player who is playing two & two bowls may not visit the head during their first two bowls, however, can visit the head before and after each of their bowls in the second two.
- c) The player playing four bowls consecutively may not visit the head while playing their bowls.

12. Centre Title

- a) The winners of the Event will receive one point towards a Bowls Auckland Gold Star,
- both players must be members of a club affiliated with Bowls Auckland.
- 2 Uniform / Drock

13. Uniform / Dress

- a) All sides are encouraged to wear matching uniform or Bowls attire.
 - i. A composite side will be permitted to wear the respective club uniform from the club each player represents.

14. Prize money:

- a) Prize money will be directly credited into a nominated bank account.
- b) Those receiving prize money should provide bank account details to the tournament convenor before leaving the venue.
