SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. These **Special Conditions of Play** need to be read in conjunction with Bowls Auckland Centre Events General Conditions of Play.

2. Dates, venues, and times

1-5 Year Men's & Women's Pairs	14–15 October 2023	28–29 October 2023
1-5 Year Fours	27–28 April 2024	22 June 2024
1-5 Year Men's & Women's Singles	8–9 June 2024	22 June 2024

- **b)** Venues: Qualifying and Post-section venues will be advised when the draw is released.
- c) Start time: All games will start by 9:00 am for each day (Singles 8:30 am)

3. Entry

Participants must be full-playing members of the same Bowls Auckland affiliated club and must be in their first five years of membership.

4. Teams

Teams in the Fours can be any combination. All other events are single-gender.

5. Playing format

- Singles Four (4) rounds played per day, Players are to provide their own markers 3 out of 4 wins are required to qualify for the post section.
 21 shots or 2 hours whichever occurs first.
 An incorrectly delivered Jack may be placed by the opposing player Four (4) bowls each.
 No time limit for the Final.
- Pairs Up to three (3) rounds per day. 18 ends or 2¼ hours, whichever occurs first Three (3) bowls each.
- TriplesUp to three (3) rounds per day.
18 ends or 2¼ hours, whichever occurs first.
Two (2) bowls each.
- Fours Up to three (3) rounds per day. 15 ends or 2¼ hours, whichever occurs first. Two (2) bowls each.

6. Marking Singles

Qualifying: Players are requested to supply a maker for this event. Where both players do not provide a marker and one is not available the game shall be completed without a marker.

Post Section: Round 1 - The host club will provide markers. Round 2 and beyond - non-winning players will need to be available to mark the next match.

7. Restricting the movement of players during play: In all games, players will only be allowed to walk up to the head as follows:

Singles After delivery of their third and fourth bowls.

In exceptional and limited circumstances, a player can ask the marker for permission to walk up to the head earlier than described above. If a player does not meet the terms of this condition, Law 13 will apply.

Pairs Leads: after delivery of their third bowl.

Skips: after delivery of their second and third bowl

Triples Leads: after the Seconds have delivered their second bowl.

Seconds: after delivery of their second bowl

Skips: after delivery of each of their bowls

Fours Leads: after the Thirds have delivered their second bowl.

Seconds: after the Thirds have delivered their second bowl

Thirds: after delivery of their second bowl

Skips: after delivery of each of their bowls

In exceptional and limited circumstances, a Skip can ask that a player walks up to the head earlier than described above. If a player does not meet the terms of this condition, Law 13 will apply.

8. Prize money: Prize money will be direct credited into a nominated bank account.
 Winner: \$200 per person per event` Runners-up: \$100 per person per event
